I also believe that George was at Green-Patch because he was working for James Stuart Sinclair (who's new homestead at Green-Patch had just been completed) as a shepherd and George & Lydia would have been living in a shepherd's hut somewhere on the Sinclair Run, where George Henry & Hero were born.
